The Semaphore & Port Adelaide RSL Committee wishes to advise of the following street closures and events with regards to the Anzac Day Dawn Service between 3.00 a.m. to 8.00 a.m. and then continuing until 2.00 p.m.:

**Temporary Street Closures:**

- The Esplanade between Newman Street and Swan Street (3.00 – 8.00 a.m.)
- Access to the Semaphore Foodland Car Park (3.00 – 8.00 a.m.)
- The northern side of Semaphore Road from the Foodland Car Park driveway to The Esplanade (3.00 – 8.00 a.m.)
- The southern side of Semaphore Road from Custom Lane to The Esplanade (3.00 a.m. – 2.00 p.m.)

The turning lane from Semaphore Road to Custom Lane will not be restricted to allow traffic flow.

The Service includes the Australian Army Band Adelaide including Bugler, Woodville High School drummers and Oceanview College students, a Scottish Piper, the Fort Glanville Historical Association firing of volleys for the 21 gun salute (no live ammunition will be used), Australian Air League cadets and Royal Australian Airforce catafalque party and P-8 Poseidon ‘flyby’.

A public address system will be temporarily erected for the service.
